Public notice – Zoning by-law amendment

To all persons interested in the first draft of a by-law to amend Zoning by-law no.03-429 and its amendments in order to authorize additional uses in zones Rr-602 and Rr-701. During the regular meeting held February 2, 2015 the council of the Municipality of La Pêche adopted the first draft of by-law no. 15-684, modifying the zoning by-law no. 03-429 and its amendments. A public consultation will be held on March 16, 2015 beginning at 7:30 p.m., in the Desjardins hall of the La Pêche sports complex, located at 20, Chemin Raphaël in La Pêche. During this meeting, the mayor or a person designated by him, will explain the draft by-law and will hear individuals or groups who wish to comment on this matter. This draft by-law contains provisions specific to a by-law subject to approval by way of a referendum, that is to say: a) add the classification 5.12.6: *para-industrial secondary use entailing a nuisance* to the authorized or prohibited uses within the zone Rr-602; b) add the specific classification 5.10.8: *rock climbing and mountain hiking* to the uses authorized or prohibited within the zone Rr-701. This first draft of by-law no.15-684 as well as a map showing the exact boundaries of the zones affected is available for reference at the municipal office, located at 1, Principale Ouest in La Pêche, during regular office hours: Monday, Tuesday and Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Wednesday and Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

To all persons interested in the draft of a by-law to amend Building by-law no. 89-149. During the regular meeting held February 16, 2015 the council of the Municipality of La Pêche adopted draft by-law no. 15-685, modifying the building by-law no. 89-149. A public consultation will be held on March 16 2015 beginning at 7:30 p.m., in the Desjardins hall of the La Pêche sports complex, located at 20, Chemin Raphaël in La Pêche. During this meeting, the mayor or a person designated by him, will explain the draft by-law and will hear individuals or groups who wish to comment on this matter. This draft by-law does not contain any provisions specific to a by-law subject to approval by way of a referendum. In particular, the purpose of this draft by-law is to add provisions regarding reinforced building structures.
