**Budget 2016**

Whereas budget estimates for the year 2016 provide for a total of  
\$13 191 625 in operating expenditures allocated as follows:

Public security.....	\$ 2 989 562

Sanitation .....	\$ 1 374 720
Health & Welfare .....	\$ 105 646

Whereas the 2016 budget also provides for capital expenditures as follows:

Administration .....	\$ 123 262
Public security.....	\$543 670
Transportation.....	\$ 2 216 707
Sanitation .....	\$ 0
Planning and development.....	\$ 2 724
Recreation and culture .....	\$ 866 944
Total:	\$ 3 753 307

Whereas specific revenues total \$ 13 191 625 including a transfer of \$ 495 735 from the accumulated surplus of 2015 and the taxable assessment value for 2016 totals \$ 1 298 890 955.

It is resolved this municipal council adopted the 2016 budget providing

- o a general tax rate of \$0,51294 per hundred dollars of assessment for the residual category and register agricultural exploitation,
- o a tax rate of \$0,71618 per hundred dollars of assessment for immovables in the non residential category
- o a tax rate of \$0,68237 per hundred dollars of assessment for buildings containing six housing units or more
- o a tax rate of 0,80817 per hundred dollars for assessment of an industrial immovable
- o a tax rate of \$0,10076 per hundred dollars of assessment for the MRC des Collines regional police force and municipal court services
- o a tax rate of \$0,06402 per hundred dollars of assessment for our contribution to the MRC des Collines general expenses

The applicable rates, including the contributions to the MRC des Collines-de-l'Outaouais, are as follows:

- o residual category: \$0,67772 hundred dollars of assessment;
- o non-residential immovables: \$0,88096 per hundred dollars of assessment;
- o buildings containing six housing units or more: \$0,84715 per hundred dollars of assessment
- o reregister agricultural exploitation \$0,67772 per hundred dollars of assessment
- o industrial immovable: \$0,97295 per hundred dollars of assessment

It is also resolved that a tariff be imposed to subsidize a legally incorporated non profit organization whose activities contributed to the construction of a multipurpose arena in La Pêche on the property purchased from Mr. Raphaël Gosselin, in the sector of Sainte-Cécile de Masham. The rate will be as follows:

- 1 to 5 lots:        \$10 per vacant lot (excluding private roads);
- plus**
- 6 to 10 lots:     \$5 per vacant lot (excluding private roads);
- plus**
- 11 lots or more: \$2 per vacant lot (excluding private roads);
- Building            40\$ per immovable listed on the evaluation role on which there is any type of building.

It is furthermore resolved to set the tax rate for garbage collection as follows:

Residence category 1 ..... (up to 5 units)	\$215/unit
Residence category 2 ..... (6 units to 10 units)	\$215/unit
Residence category 3 ..... (11 units to 20 units)	\$215/unit
Business category A.....	\$410/unit
Business category B.....	\$620/unit
Business category C.....	\$1 555/unit
Business category D.....	\$2 360/unit
Business category E.....	\$4 500/unit
Schools.....	\$4 300/unit

It is resolved that the municipal council adopt the triennial immobilisation plan as presented.
