Issuing of parking passes at Philippe Lake

La Pêche, June 14, 2016 - The Municipality of La Pêche receives 750 passes annually from the National Capital Commission (NCC) for accessing the Philippe Lake parking lot in Sainte-Cécile-de-Masham, which are distributed to permanent residents.

In order to facilitate access in 2016, the NCC has invested in order to provide a better quality pass that is easier to use. However, the municipality will have to collect back the passes at the end of the summer.

- Each citizen who receives a 2016 pass will have to return it to the Municipality between September 6 and October 31, 2016.
- If the 2016 pass is not returned within the specified time, you and any household member will be **denied** a pass next year (2017).

Distribution of the passes will begin Saturday, June 18, 2016 at 8:00 am at the administrative office of the Municipality of La Pêche at 1, route Principale Ouest. The doors will close at 12:00 noon. If there are remaining passes, they will be distributed starting Monday, June 20, during regular office hours.

To get your pass, it is mandatory that you go to the municipal office with your valid driver's license showing your home address in La Pêche. We issue only one pass per residence (address). Note that the number of passes is limited, so it is on a first come, first served basis. You will also need to complete a loan form committing to returning the pass at the end of the summer season.
