2016 Lac Philippe Parking Passes

Every year, the Municipality receives parking passes from the National Capital Commission for Lac Philippe. They are distributed to **permanent residents** of La Pêche. Passes will be available as of Saturday June 18, 2016 from 8:00 a.m. to noon at the municipal office located at 1, Route Principale Ouest. To obtain a parking pass, **you must come to the municipal office in person and present your valid drivers' licence, showing your residential address in La Pêche.** Only one pass may be issued per residence. Please note that the number of passes is limited, therefore they are available on a first come, first served basis.
