### NOTICE TO ANYONE INTERESTED IN BECOMING A MEMBER OF THE LA PÊCHE RECREATION, CULTURE AND COMMUNITY LIVING COMMITTEE (RCCLC)

---

The Recreation, Culture and Community Living Committee (RCCLC) is currently looking for three (3) residents of La Pêche who would be interested in one of the following positions:

- One (1) representative from the recreation (leisure) sector
- One (1) representative from the sports sector
- One (1) representative from the community living (social) sector

The Committee is charged with examining and analyzing matters related to recreation, culture and community living in the Municipality of La Pêche. It makes recommendations to the Recreation, Culture and Community Living Department on the planning, organization and evaluation of issues concerning the Department's areas of activity.

In 2016-2017, the Committee's mandate will include supporting the Recreation, Culture and Community Living Department in carrying out certain components of the action plan for implementing the Recreation, Culture and Community Living Policy adopted on April 4, 2016.

In collaboration with the Recreation, Culture and Community Living Department, the Committee will also have a mandate to:

- a) encourage and foster the initiatives of groups and organizations providing recreation, culture and community living services in the community;
- b) work on ad hoc projects identified in collaboration with the Department; and
- g) participate in working groups for specific projects.

The Committee consists of nine (9) members, as follows:

- Two (2) elected officials (councillors)
- Five (5) residents of the Municipality of La Pêche
- The head of the Recreation, Culture and Community Living Department
- A committee secretary assigned by Administrative Services

The Committee normally meets once a month. Its members may also be called upon to participate in working groups requiring additional meetings from time to time. A member's commitment is for two years.

Selected individuals will be appointed by council resolution, based on a recommendation from the selection committee. Applications will be evaluated against a set of predetermined criteria, including:

- availability to attend meetings on a regular basis;
- interest in matters pertaining to recreation, culture and community living;
- personal and professional experience in recreation, culture and community living;
- awareness of issues pertaining to recreation, culture and community living; and
- how representative the candidate's profile is of a given sector.

Successful candidates will be required to sign a commitment to impartiality that will formalize their willingness to promote the collective interest in a spirit of consensus. They will also be required to sign a declaration of conflict of interest.

Applications must be submitted in writing and contain the following information:

- Name and home address
- Number of years of residency in the municipality
- Relevant experience
- A statement expressing the person's interest in recreation, culture and community living
- A statement explaining how the person feels they could contribute to the Committee
