Notice of By-Law no. 16-702 coming into effect

To amend the Zoning By-Law no. 03-429 and its amendments, with respect to the Zone CRT-601 and establishing the new Zone CRT-605

Notice is hereby given as follows:

1. During the regular meeting held March 21, 2016 the council of the Municipality of La Pêche adopted a by-law, no. 16-702, modifying the zoning by-law no. 03-429 and its amendments in order to authorize integrated projects, modify the authorized and prohibited categories of uses and types of constructions within the zone CRT-601 and establish the new zone CRT-605.
2. Such by-law was referred to the MRC des Collines-de-l'Outaouais for the purpose of ensuring conformity with the revised master plan and accompanying document.
3. On April 22, 2016 the secretary-treasurer of the MRC des Collines-de-l'Outaouais issued a certificate to the effect that such by-law is consistent with the purpose to be served by the revised master plan of the MRC des Collines-de-l'Outaouais and the provisions which are included in the accompanying document.
4. Such by-law came into effect on April 22, 2016, the date of issue of the certificate of conformity.
5. By-law no. 16-702, amending the zoning by-law no. 03-429 and its amendments, is available for reference at the municipal office, located at 1, Principale Ouest in La Pêche, during regular office hours: Monday, Tuesday and Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Wednesday and Thursday, from 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
