Adoption of Concordance By-Law no. 16-720

Modifying the Zoning By-Law no. 03-429 and its amendments

Notice is given to any person concerned:

That during a special meeting held July 25, 2016 the council of the Municipality of La Pêche adopted the concordance by-law no. 16-720, modifying the zoning by-law no. 03-429 and its amendments; that the adoption of such concordance by-law was necessary in order to ensure that the zoning by-law no. 03-429 and its amendments are in accordance with the planning program (03-428), modified by the by-law no. 16-719, also adopted during the special meeting held July 25, 2016; that the purpose of such concordance by-law is to expand the Pa-601 zone (Public and community) by adding to it part of the Rr-603 zone (Residential rural); that the Pa-601 and Rr-603 zones are located in the Wakefield sector, near the intersection of MacLaren Road and Highway 105; that any person qualified to vote in the territory of the Municipality of La Pêche can make a written request to the Commission municipale du Québec (20, rue Chauveau, Québec, G1R 4J3), in order to obtain its opinion regarding the conformity of the concordance by-law no. 16-720 with the planning program (03-428) modified by the by-law no. 16-719; that if the Commission receives at least five (5) requests relating to the concordance by-law no. 16-720 from persons qualified to vote in the Municipality of La Pêche territory, within sixty (60) days following the deadline of August 30, 2016, it must provide an opinion with regard to the conformity of the concordance by-law with the planning program; that if the Commission does not receive at least five (5) requests from persons qualified to vote in the Municipality of La Pêche territory regarding the concordance by-law no. 16-720, within the time limit stipulated in this notice, this by-law will be deemed to be in accordance with the planning program as amended by the by-law no. 16-719. By-law no. 16-719 and the concordance by-law no. 16-720 are available for reference at the Municipality of La Pêche office, located at 1, route Principale Ouest in La Pêche, during regular office hours: Monday, Tuesday and Friday, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Wednesday and Thursday, from 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. or go to the Municipality's Web site at www.villelapeche.qc.ca.

Eurasian Water-Milfoil – Lac des Loups

Following a request from the Lac des Loups Association in 2015, the ABV7 (Agency of 7 Watersheds), whose mandate is to protect and improve the water quality of the seven main rivers flowing through its territory, has taken an inventory of Eurasian water-milfoil plant beds in Lac-des-Loups. According to the Agency's report: "in order to contain the rapid spread of Eurasian water-milfoil, the implementation of short term control measures such as the use of buoys and signage to restrict powercraft traffic (in the vicinity of plant beds) is recommended, pending more specific control action". The Lac-des-Loups Association has formed a committee to propose a long-term solution. The public will be informed of any developments.
