NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN TO ALL PEOPLE INTERESTED IN BECOMING A MEMBER OF THE LA PÊCHE RECREATION, CULTURE AND COMMUNITY LIVING COMMITTEE

The Recreation, Culture and Community living Committee (RCCL) is presently searching for one (1) new member, among the residents of the La Pêche Municipality.

The Committee's role consists of analysing different dossiers related to recreation, culture and community living in the Municipality of La Pêche. It will offer advice and make recommendations to the Department of Recreation, Culture and Community Living in the areas of planning, organization and evaluation of policies, programmes and activities that fall under the Department's mandate.

More specifically the mandate of the committee for 2018 will be related to the following subjects:

- a) Orientation plans with priorities for infrastructures over the next four (4) years;
- b) Evolution of the needs of the citizens regarding recreation, culture and community living.

In collaboration with the Department of Recreation, Culture and Community Living, the committee will also have a mandate:

- c) To support, encourage and foster initiatives from various groups and organizations providing recreation, culture and community living services in the community;
- d) To work on ad hoc projects identified in collaboration with the Department.
- e) To participate on working groups for specific projects.

The Recreation, Culture and Community Living Committee, will consist of nine (9) members as follows:

- Two (2) elected members of the Municipal Council;
- One (1) representative from the cultural sector;
- One (1) representative from the community living sector;
- One (1) representative from the recreation sector;
- One (1) representative from the sports sector;
- One (1) general representative from no particular sector;
- The director of Recreation, Culture and Community Living
- A secretary.

This committee will normally meet once a month. Moreover, members can be called upon to participate in working groups on specific issues. A member's commitment is for a period of two years.

The members will be appointed by council, upon the recommendation from the selection committee. Applications will be evaluated according to various criteria, notably:

- availability to participate on a regular base;
- interest in matters relating to recreation, culture and community living;
- personal and professional experience in recreation, culture and community living;
- awareness of issues surrounding recreation, culture and community living
- how representative a candidate's profile is of a given sector;

Successful candidates will be asked to sign a commitment to impartiality that will officialise the candidate's willingness to favour collective interests in a spirit of consensus. Successful candidates will also be asked to sign a declaration of conflict of interest.

Interested persons are invited to apply in writing. The following information is required with your application:

- Your name and home address;
- The number of years of residency in the municipality;
- An expression of why you are interested in recreation, culture and community living in La Pêche;
- A statement of what you believe your contribution would be to the Recreation, Culture and Community Living Committee.

Applications should be submitted by *February 2nd, 2018 at the latest*, to the address indicated below.
