LA PÊCHE AWARDED A \$50,000 ASSET MANAGEMENT GRANT

La Pêche, July 15, 2020 – The Municipality of La Pêche is pleased to announce that it has been awarded a \$50,000 grant from the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) to develop and implement an asset management plan. The Municipality will conduct an asset management needs assessment to serve as the basis for a plan that will improve its ability to make annual financial projections. There are three priority areas:

- A master plan for parks and green spaces and an analysis of the current state of municipal buildings will be used to establish short-term and medium-term maintenance and improvement plans that incorporate the needs of the community and the Municipality's current and future assets.
- **Vehicles and acquisition of preventive maintenance software** to better assess the state of the Municipality's vehicles and make plans to replace them as needed.

The Municipality is committed to getting a handle on municipal asset management by making it one of the operational strategies in the 2019–2023 Strategic Plan. A committee will be struck soon to start making headway on that front.

Getting the grant is a big step in carrying out our 2019–2023 Strategic Plan and will promote efficient, planned management of La Pêche assets. On behalf of our community, I would like to congratulate the finance team on the award and I am also grateful to the Federation of Canadian Municipalities.
