## Giant Hogweed

It is important to properly identify Giant Hogweed so as not to mistake it for cow-parsnip (or common cow-parsnip) which looks very similar. Giant hogweed causes severe burns if you get the sap on your skin and the skin is exposed to sunlight. To control the spread of Giant hogweed, you must remove as much of the root as possible just before it produces seeds. Using a spade, you cut off the roots at a depth of about 20 cm, ideally in early spring. Repeat the process several times throughout the year. When handling this plant, you must totally cover up with protective clothing and eye wear and protect your face as well. Boat cleaning beginning May 19: if you are going to launch your boat at Lac Sinclair, don't forget to stop at the boat washing station located at the East-Aldfield community centre parking lot and use the pressure washer to clean your boat as well as your trailer before you put them in the lake. This cleaning facility has been provided thanks to the joint efforts of various partners: the Ste-Sophie d'Aldfield community centre, which supplies the electricity and water; the Pembroke archdiocese, which allows the use of the parking lot; the Regroupement pour la protection de l'eau de la Vallée-de-la-Gatineau, which provides the pressure washer and equipment as well as the auxiliary signalling and the Municipality of La Pêche, who supports our work with grants.
