Giant Hogweed

It is important to properly identify Giant Hogweed so as not to mistake it for cow-parsnip (or common cow-parsnip) which looks very similar. Giant hogweed causes severe burns if you get the sap on your skin and the skin is exposed to sunlight. To control the spread of Giant hogweed, you must remove as much of the root as possible just before it produces seeds. Using a spade, you cut off the roots at a depth of about 20 cm, ideally in early spring. Repeat the process several times throughout the year. When handling this plant, you must totally cover up with protective clothing and eye wear and protect your face as well. RénoVert Tax Credit Extension - Septic System Upgrades

The government of Québec is providing tax assistance in 2017 in order to help protect the environment. The tax measure benefits taxpayers who wish to upgrade their residential sewage treatment facilities (septic tanks). The tax credit amounts to 20% of eligible expenses in excess of \$2500, up to a maximum of \$5500, for principal and second residences. Notice to Dog Owners

According to By-law no. 13-RM-02, stray dogs within the municipal territory are considered a nuisance or violation and the dog's keeper (owner) is liable to penalties as stipulated in the by-law. Clause 7.1 of the by-law states that it is not permitted to have a dog at large outside the keeper's building, dwelling or property (your property). Beyond these limits, the dog's keeper must have the dog on a leash or otherwise control and supervise the animal at all times. A dog is deemed not to be controlled by his keeper when it is not on a leash. In addition to a fine of \$200, you may have to pay transportation costs as well as boarding fees
